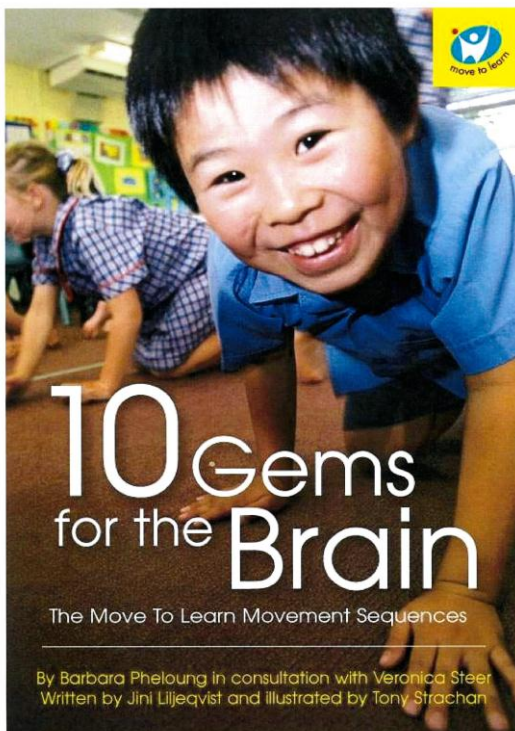
A practical HANDS ON taster for Teachers, Educations Assistants, Parents and Childcare workers to assist all children towards reaching their potential.
